Find the answers to the following questions as you walk around the museum. Hint; All the answers can be found in the museum. When asked for a location you can answer with Spitfire Hall or Hurricane Hall. Always indicate directions (left or right) by pointing yourself in the same direction as the Spitfire or Hurricane are pointed.

5. Can you find an example of a Ration Book? What is it used for? **Hint:** The Home Front Display might be a good starting point.
6. In a cabinet there's a model of a plane resembling a Spitfire that floats on water. What is it called?

1. What material covers the tail of the Hurricane on display?
2. Can you find an example of an RAF pilot's wings (or pilot's brevet as it's officially known)?

4. Can you find the name of the company that made the motorcycle in the Hurricane Hall?
5. There is a pair of gloves that belonged to a pilot named 'Billy'. Can you find them?

7. Look on the floor of the Hurricane hall near the plane. What was a pilot's life jacket called?
